OIL PIPELINE TARIFF FILING

Re: Pelican Gathering Systems, LLC—Tariff Filing

Dear Secretary Bose:

In compliance with the Interstate Commerce Act, 49 U.S.C. § 1 *et seq.*, and the Rules and Regulations of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”), 18 C.F.R. Part 341, Pelican Gathering Systems, LLC (“Pelican”) hereby submits for filing F.E.R.C. No. 2.8.0 to become effective April 1, 2018.

I. Explanation of Tariff Filing

Pelican is filing F.E.R.C. No. 2.8.0 to implement a new pumpover charge that will apply to any barrels of crude petroleum that are transported through the connection at Sacagawea Pipeline, New Town, Mountrail County, North Dakota (“Sacagawea Connection”), which is a current destination point in the tariff. In response to a shipper request, Pelican undertook improvements to the Sacagawea Connection that will increase the capacity and reliability of the connection. Pelican has made new infrastructure investments and will incur ongoing maintenance costs as a result of such improvements. Therefore, as indicated in F.E.R.C. No. 2.8.0, effective April 1, 2018, Pelican will assess a pumpover charge in addition to the applicable rates set forth in the Table of Rates, for any barrels of crude petroleum that are transported through the Sacagawea Connection.

As required by 18 C.F.R. § 342.2(b) (Establishing Initial Rates), Pelican is filing with this tariff a sworn affidavit that the new pumpover charge at the Sacagawea Connection has been agreed to by at least one non-affiliated person who intends to use such transportation service.

In addition, Pelican is cancelling language on the cover page of the tariff seeking special permission to file the tariff on less than 30 days’ notice, because such language is not applicable to this tariff filing. Pelican has not changed any of its currently-effective rates, routing, rules or regulations in F.E.R.C. No. 2.8.0.

II. Certification

Rates from any origin not specified above to any of the destinations listed above or any origin point to a destination point not specified above shall be charged a rate in accordance with the provisions of 18 C.F.R. § 341.10. Pursuant to 18 CFR 341.10(a)(2) Carrier will file a tariff publication applicable to these transportation movements if the intermediate point is to be used on a continuous basis for more than 30 days.
